I'm proud to inform you that Clover Garden earned a B letter grade, having met the Department of Public Instruction's growth expectation for the 2018- 2019 school year. We met growth expectations in all areas, (exceeded growth in math) and scored an overall 84.7% in growth. We made a 75% as an overall school performance score which is an increase from the 71% that we scored from the 2017-2018 school year. The numbers only tell part of the story.
