

Frequently Asked Questions from the Expansion Survey sent out in April:

Question	Answer
Where will the expansion be built?	Within 2.5 miles of the current location of Clover Garden School.
What is the timeline for this project?	Due to COVID-19 this information is left to be decided. The goal is to expand within the next 5 years.
How will the arts and sports be considered in this expansion plan?	CGS is a school that is known for our arts program. These areas will only be enhanced by this expansion.
Will small class size be a focus with the expansion?	Clover Garden School was created with the expectation that small class sizes would offer individualized attention to all students. Small class sizes ideally are limited to 20 or less students per classroom. This will be the goal of each incoming class beginning with the kindergarten classes enrolling during the 2020-2021 school year.
Will all the age groups still have the	Yes, one of our core values at CGS is community. We intend to keep

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opportunity to mingle and work together?	our students tight-knit and engaged in school-wide activities throughout the school year. We value the relationships that our older students build as mentors and leaders for our younger students. We will continue to work towards keeping that bond strong.
How will the family feel be fostered?	Please see the above answer
What will bus transportation look like?	Clover Garden School will continue to provide bus transportation to both locations. There will be a modified schedule so that buses can drop off students at both locations in the morning and pick students up from both locations in the afternoon. The expansion campus will be in close proximity to our current CGS campus.
How will the curriculum be expanded? Trade classes? More electives?	With our expansion campus, we will be able to provide our students with additional resources and flexibility that now operating as a K-12 school we are unable to do. We will continue adding trade courses and elective courses that

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	will prepare our <i>CGS</i> students to be college and career ready.
Will there be separate drop off times for each campus to allow for travel time?	Yes, there will be a slightly altered schedule to ensure all of our students are able to get to campus safely and on time.
Were the students asked their opinion of this expansion idea?	Yes, all students were sent the same survey as the parents, teachers, and incoming families.
Why can the school not expand on the current property? There is enough room for a HS building there.	Unfortunately, we have exhausted all possible avenues as it pertains to expansion on our current campus. The soil conditions are not suitable for an additional or larger septic system. Expanding on our current property is not feasible.
