CGS Families,

Each school year, NC releases a school report card. The purpose of this school report card is to inform families of the school's overall performance scores on End of Year standardized assessments. During the 2019-2020 school year, the End of Year Assessments were "waived" and students did not complete them due to the Covid-19 pandemic. For the 2020-21 school year, the U.S. Department of Education and the North Carolina General Assembly (Session Law 2021-130) waived requirements for reporting the school-level accountability model and School Performance Grades; including achievement and growth. For the 2021-2022 school year, End of Year Assessments will resume as normal for our CGS students.

Due to not having actual school report card proficiency data for the 2020-2021 school year, our school's Data Team created data based on the information we collected from student scores at the conclusion of the 2020-2021 school year and created our own version of a school report card. Our "CGS Report Card Version" is listed below. NC School Report cards with normal collected data will resume at the conclusion of the 2021-2022 school year. In all courses and grades, 59.8% of Clover Garden students scored a Level 3 or above and were grade level proficient in 2020-21 compared to 73% in 2018-2019, the last school year tested. Although we experienced an overall decline, Clover Garden students demonstrated a range of proficiency results across the grade levels and content areas with a high of 21.9% positive growth to a low of a 34.1% decline.

We have already seen a vast improvement in overall student achievement through NC Check In assessments this school year and hope to see those same positive results on this year's NC School Report Card.
